## **Air scouring in Trafalgar and Yarragon**

Gippsland Water's commitment to planned routine maintenance of water pipelines will see works in Trafalgar and Yarragon over the next few weeks. This follows on from scouring works in Neerim South in September.

The high velocity scouring process cleans the inside of pipes by removing residue that builds-up naturally from water flow inside the pipes over a period of time.

This work will occur between the 22<sup>nd</sup> November to 24 December, and night works will be undertaken in the central business district.

Customers may experience a temporary milky appearance in their water which is caused by residual air in the water following the scouring. This disappears over time and has no impact on the water quality.

The scouring is part of Gippsland Water's ongoing scheduled Water Quality Maintenance Program.
