About the SORF

Gippsland Water's Soil and Organic Recycling Facility is eastern Victoria's leading waste management complex that treats and recycles liquid and solid prescribed industrial waste.

Since 1985, the Environment Protection Authority licensed facility has been providing economic and sustainable waste management solutions to local and state-wide organisations.

The facility offers clients cost-effective treatment for organic wastes that are not available anywhere else in the state. It treats contaminated soils for beneficial reuse, creating an environmentally acceptable and sustainable solution for clients who need to remove and manage potentially hazardous contaminated soils from communities.



Time is money - well, not always! You may not be aware but there is an alternative prescribed waste facility in Gippsland that could accept your waste.

The Soil and Organic Recycling Facility (SORF) is located approximately 20 kilometres south of Sale, or two hours 45 minutes' drive from the Melbourne CBD. The facility is licensed by the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) and accepts a range of prescribed and non-prescribed wastes.

It may be time to think BIG, and consider transporting your waste in larger loads or just compare and save \$\$\$\$. One call may be well worth it!
