Futureproofing Baw Baw

Our projects in Baw Baw Shire will help us keep ahead of rapid growth.

In Warragul, we're upgrading the wastewater treatment plant to meet the town's growing needs. We're also building a new section of sewer so we can transport larger volumes of wastewater to our wastewater treatment plant.

In Drouin, we're building a new water main in the north-west to cater for growth in the area.

In Yarragon, we're upgrading the wastewater pump station in Factory Road and building a new 8.5km sewer main to support local growth.

Secure water in Wellington

Our projects in Wellington will secure water supplies in the area.

We're completing a water main extension at Cobains Road, Sale to support growth. Our Heyfield and Seaspray water treatment plants will get new covers and liners on their treated water storage basins.

We're upgrading the Maffra raw water pump station and securing a new bore to give Briagolong a more secure water source.

Water and sewer main upgrades

We're constantly replacing ageing water mains and upgrading sewer mains right across our service area. So far in 2024-25, we've relined almost 6km of sewer main in Traralgon and Morwell; and we've replaced almost 5km of water mains in Morwell, Traralgon, Churchill, Sale and Stratford. We'll be replacing more water mains in Newborough, Noojee, Sale, Wurruk, Heyfield and Maffra over the coming year.

System replacement

We're replacing the technology we use to remotely monitor and control our systems (SCADA). This will ensure our infrastructure remains reliable and secure as the current system is nearing end of life.



Expanding Gippsland Regional Organics

Gippsland Regional Organics, our waste treatment and composting business in Dutson Downs, is undergoing a major expansion so it can recycle more organic materials and produce more compost products.

This expansion will help to keep bills down for our customers, by generating revenue to help offset operating costs.



Growing with Latrobe

In the Latrobe Valley, we're strengthening the water supply networks and facilities.

A series of major infrastructure projects will shore up the water supply to Traralgon, Morwell, Tyers and surrounding towns:

- We're constructing a 50ML water storage at Clarkes Road, Traralgon to store more water for supplying Traralgon, Morwell, Glengarry, Toongabbie, Cowwarr and Rosedale.
- We'll build a new major water main to connect the Traralgon water treatment plant to the Clarkes Road water storage basin.
- We'll build a new water main to connect customers in Glengarry, Toongabbie, Cowwarr and Rosedale to the Traralgon water treatment plant.

In Moe, we're installing a new liner and cover on the treated water storage basin at the water treatment plant to further secure the water supply into the future.
