

# NATIONAL WATER WEEK



**Theme:** Water Heroes: Save Every Drop

**Target Group:** Foundation to Grade 2 (ages 6-8)

## Learning Objectives

- Understand the importance of water and its everyday uses.
- Explore what it means to be a 'Water Hero'.
- Encourage creative expression through art and poster-making.
- Promote environmental responsibility in young learners.

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## Discussion Prompts

Use these questions to spark thoughtful conversation.

- How do we use water every day?
- What is a Hero? What might it mean to be a Water Hero?
- Why is water important? What might happen if we don't look after it?
- Can you think of ways to use less water?
- How can you help others save water too?

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## Activity 1: Water In Our Day

Help students explore how water is used in their day. Let them draw or list:

- water use at home (e.g. brushing teeth, cooking)
- water use at school (e.g. drinking, washing hands)
- water use at play (e.g. water play, sports).

Encourage them to think of one way they can save water in each place; at home, at school or at play.

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## Activity 2: My Water Hero

Have students create their very own Water Hero! Ask them to:

- choose a name for their Water Hero
- describe or draw their special water-saving superpower
- illustrate their Water Hero in action!

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## Activity 3: Poster Planning Time!

Use the Mind Map on 3a to help students create their final artwork. Then have students sketch a rough draft of their poster. Remind them to think about:

- their message (e.g. "Save Every Drop!")
- pictures of water, heroes, or actions
- colour and design to make it eye-catching.

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## Extension Idea: Water-Saving Slogan

As a class or in small groups, brainstorm catchy slogans together. Examples:

- "Be a Hero – Save Every Drop"
- "Water is Precious – Don't Waste It"
- "Turn Off the Tap, Be a Water Hero"
