Our network

We manage a \$2.3 billion network that provides water and wastewater services across our region including Moondarra Reservoir which supplies around 50,500ML (50.5 billion litres) of water from the Tyers River to the Latrobe Valley each year.

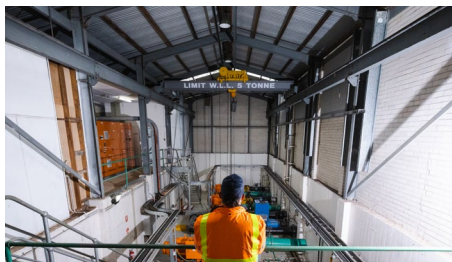

Planning for growth and industry needs

We plan for the short, medium and long term to ensure sustainable and secure water supplies for our communities and industries, now and into the future. Our planning considers population growth, climate change, changing industry needs and the condition of our assets.

Managing ageing assets

We build infrastructure for the long term and manage it throughout its lifecycle, from design and construction through to upgrades, renewal and replacement. We use growth forecasts, climate data, hydraulic modelling and condition monitoring to identify when assets need upgrading or replacing, helping us maintain reliable services while delivering value for customers.

How we decide where to invest

Our planning processes prioritise investment where it's needed most and aim to balance this with what customers can afford.

We're looking 50 years ahead to sustainably support growth of our region to:

- maintain reliable water and wastewater services
- keep our assets maintained and resilient
- deliver the services our customers need and want.

We work closely with councils and others to align plans and coordinate assets for new development and business.

As Victoria's largest industrial water and wastewater provider, we support major industries and plan for new opportunities as the Latrobe Valley economy evolves and industry demand changes.

Capital expenditure

For Price Submission 2028-23 we are currently forecasting about \$450M in capital expenditure. This will be used to renew existing assets and invest in new assets to support growth and compliance.

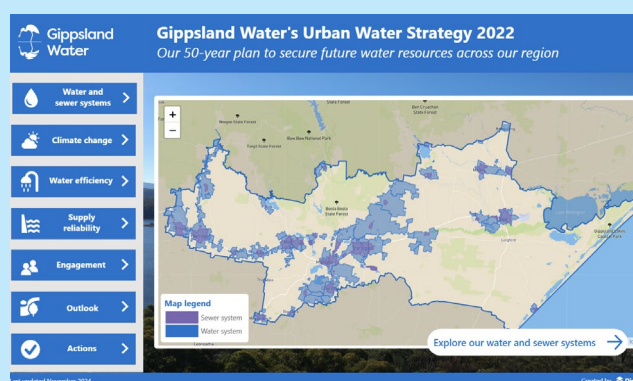
This will be made up of large projects (called our Top 10 projects), renewal programs and minor projects.
